If you have a legal background, or just a knack for creating standard forms, you can start a good online business selling them to consumers you don't even need to meet. Many people search the Internet for standard forms to download such as rental and eviction forms, customizable contract examples, vendor forms and application forms that can be integrated into a business. Create your form in a standard word processing program like Microsoft Word. Forms should be easy to edit as you may need to make changes to the form you will offer online at a later date. Convert your form to PDF format. If the form is filled in, use Adobe Acrobat to create a form field in the document that can be easily filled in online and printed by the user (see Resources for more information on creating fillable forms in Acrobat). Zip your file to be sent to customers online (optional if you sell only one form per transaction). If you want, add a password to each zip file as an additional layer of protection and email the password automatically to the person who ordered the form. Open a PayPal you can receive payments online instantly. You can also contact your credit card merchant service provider to get your own personalized merchant number. Also open a PayPal account because it integrates well with the services you may need to complete a transaction. Create a simple website to view and sell your forms (see Resources for sample sites). Buy a hosting plan that allows you enough bandwidth to accommodate all the forms to be downloaded from the site. Create a simple homepage that provides information about your small business and a clear list of all the forms available for download. Create information and descriptive pages for each form. Write each page with SEO, or search engine optimization, in mind (see Resources for basic SEO concepts). Sign up for an account with Payloadz.com. The site offers convenient file delivery services at an additional cost. When you use Payloadz, a unique activation key will be created for each customer and an IP address will be recorded to ensure that no one except the buyer can download the information from the site. This is the best option if you're worried about your shared form. Clickbank.com also offers similar paid services. MediaFire MediaFire is a cloud storage system that offers up to 50GB of free storage, with 1 TB of storage coming in for just \$3.75 per month. If you have a free plan, there is a maximum upload size of 20GB, but this restriction is missing with one of the paid options. MediaFire has apps on a variety of devices, so you can transfer large files online from your mobile device as well as from a laptop. pCloud pCloud cloud storage services that have a dedicated file transfer system.
